WELCOME INFO

Dear Coach,

Congratulations on your team's advancement to the Special Olympics Ontario 2020 Provincial School Championships (School Championships). The School Championships will take place in Kingston, ON from June 2-4, 2020 and are proudly hosted by the Kingston Police. We are thrilled to be able to host 1,000 athletes and coaches from all over Ontario for the 2020 School Championships and look forward to welcoming you to beautiful Kingston!

As move on from the amazing 2019 Invitational Youth Games and shift back to our regular rotation of School Championships, we have been overwhelmed by the outpouring of support for the Special Olympics movement and our School Championships program in Ontario, throughout Canada, and around the world. The 2020 School Championships in Kingston will be the perfect successor to the 2019 Invitational Youth Games and each and every high school team who attended a qualifier and advanced to the 2020 School Championships can know that they worked hard and advanced against the most participants we have ever had participate in our School Championships program!

You will have noticed that the introduction of Unified Sports in schools has become a staple of our programming. We have continued to include a Unified division at all of our 75+ Provincial Qualifiers as well as at the 2020 School Championships. Unified Sports is the unique interconnecting of athletes with and without intellectual disabilities in sport. Each of our five sports will offer a Traditional and Unified Division in Kingston.

This year we are expecting 1,000 athletes and coaches from all over Ontario. The 2020 School Championships in Kingston will (approximately) qualify:

- Soccer – 14 teams
- Basketball – 29 teams
- Track and Field – 175 athletes
- Bocce – 29 teams
- Floor Hockey – 13 teams

Please Note that the registration fee for this year's games will be \$50.00 per athletes (coaches do not pay). This registration fee includes:

- **Transportation** to and from Kingston. Pick-up will be in your hometown and Special Olympics Ontario will book all transportation. Two-weeks prior to the 2020 School Championships you will receive a travel itinerary. Depending on your exact location, some schools may take the train, be booked on a flight, or have to meet a bus at a central location.



- **Internal transportation** in Kingston to and from all sporting venues, ceremonies, and residences.
- Two nights' **accommodation** in Kingston (June 2 and June 3) at the Athlete's Village.
- **Meals** for every day of the Games:
 - June 2nd – Lunch and Dinner
 - June 3rd – Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner
 - June 4th – Breakfast
- Great competition, awesome swag, and lasting memories!

Please note: based on the location and timing of Games, some teams may be required to travel to Kingston on June 1st. Should this be the case our team will reach out to you individually and accommodation and meals will be covered for June 1st in your registration.

Every coach needs to be registered in order to attend the 2020 School Championships. The coach registration form is available on the Coaches Corner website. Please complete these forms ASAP. Please note that coaches who have not completed their forms prior to Games will not be able to attend.

All team sports must submit skills assessment test results. Full information can be found on the Coaches Corner website. These results assist our team to ensure a safe and fair competition and divisioning process for all. Forms are due **May 5th, 2020**

In order to participate in the School Championships, students-athletes must be registered (this is separate from your team information form). These forms are required for all participants, regardless if they have competed in the past. Each attending athlete must submit a completed student-athlete form (link on the Coaches Corner) completed by a parent or guardian. Please ensure parents/guardians complete these forms ASAP. Please note that athletes who have not completed their forms prior to Games will not be able to attend. Our team will stay connected with you to confirm who on your team has submitted forms.

Please note that if you are asked to meet the bus at a central location your transportation to that location will NOT be provided by SOO. The same with transportation to a train station or airport.

DETAILS OF ACCOMMODATION

Queen's University – various residence buildings

Exact room locations and buildings are still TBD. Information on rooms and buildings will be posted on the website and an updated version of this package will be available once information has been finalized.

***Important*:** We will make every effort to room all schools together regardless of sport, however there may be some circumstances where this is not possible based on the room allocations given to us. In this case, some schools may be separated by team. **Please plan for supervision accordingly.**

Athlete & Coach Rooms: (Final building assignments will be sent to each coach at least 2 weeks prior to Games)

- Single and double rooms.
- Athletes and coaches cannot share a room unless approved by SOO and with written approval from your school administration.
- Occupants of each room will be single gender only, unless approved by SOO and with written approval from your school administration.
- Floors will be multi-gender or single-gendered depending on the residence type.
- Rooms will either have in-suite washrooms shared with a roommate or a bank of washrooms per floor shared with other floor occupants (all Games participants). For multi-gendered floors, washrooms will be marked by gender.
- Each room will come with linens, pillows and towels. All participants must bring their own soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.
- Each residence will have a front desk employee, a security member, and a nurse on call 24/7.
- Each residence will have Special Olympics staff dispersed throughout the residence
- An SOO staff member and residence staff with a master key to all rooms will be available 24 hrs/day.

- Each school has been asked to name one student to carry your school sign in to the opening ceremony. Information can be completed on the Ceremonies section of the Team Registration Form found on the Coaches Corner website.
- Special Olympics Ontario will provide all signs.
- Loud noises and flashing lights will be part of the Opening Ceremonies. We are working to produce live streaming. More information will be provided closer to the date.
- ***All Athletes & Coaches are required to attend Opening and Closing Ceremonies***

NOTE FOR FANS & FAMILIES: As there are a limited number of seats available, fans wishing to attend the ceremonies must pre-register to secure a free ticket. Registration will be posted closer to the date on the Games website at <http://schoolchamps.ca/>

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Healthy Athletes:

Once again this year, we are happy to announce that we will be hosting a Healthy Athletes expo open to all competing athletes. These free health and nutrition booths and sessions will be set up at each competition venue, and built into your competition schedule. Each athlete will need a release form signed by a parent/guardian to participate (found in the student-athlete form).



Want to leave early? Not stay overnight?

We recognize that two overnights away from home can be very hard for some teams. Although we strongly encourage all athletes to stay in the Athletes Village for two nights to gain the full Games experience, this is ultimately not mandatory. Should you wish to stray from the transportation or accommodation plan, please let us know immediately.

Note: regardless of your school plan, the registration of \$50/athlete remains the same, and all schools are required to cover the cost of any transportation that strays from the plan.

One-Way Texting Platform:

During the Games we will be using a one-way texting platform to communicate with all coaches. This will allow us to send out real-time updates on and unforeseen changes or updates. It is required that each coach provide consent for phone numbers to be used for this platform. Please see the Coach Registration Form to affirm consent. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

Media Requests:

Leading up to the Games, our marketing department will be alerting local media of your team's advancement. As a result, there may be media requests that come to us to cover your team either at the event, at a practice, or to partake in an interview leading up to the event. Should this occur you will be contacted directly by the School Championships team. If you wish to alert any contacts you may have in the local media please feel free to pass along the coverage so we can share it!

Additional Educators:

We recognize that some teams and athletes may need extra support at the Games. Requests for an extra educator/coach can be submitted online through the Coaches Corner website (<http://schoolchamps.ca/coach/>) Approvals will be made on a first come, first served basis as we have limited accommodation space. **The costs of an additional educator is \$350** which must be picked up by the participating school or individual.
